COURSE AIM:

This course is perfect for those who wish to achieve a qualification and want the flexibility of a part time course. The part time choice is slightly more intensive due to the reduced hours but it maintains the fun and experimental salon aspects of our other provision. Students also have the opportunity to participate in educational trips, competitions and promotional events to enhance their learning.

Candidates must have already achieved a Level 2 Hairdressing Qualification

A Hairdressing/Barbering NVQ can jump-start your career - with a Level 1 Hairdressing qualification you can get your first Salon Assistant job, and with the higher levels you could become a stylist and go on to be a Salon Manager.

COURSE CONTENT:

Candidates will be expected to attend college one day/week for underpinning knowledge, and assessment will also take place in the workplace on a regular basis. This course is both theory and practical based. The framework consists of:

- Level 2 NVQ Diploma in Barbering including:
 - • health and safety
 - • client consultation
 - • shampoo and condition the hair & scalp
 - • promote products and services
 - • cut men's hair
 - • cut facial hair
 - • styling men's hair
 - • colour and lighten hair
 - • perm and neutralise
 - • salon reception duties
- Essential Skills Wales: Application of Number (Level 1), Communication (Level 1) and IT (Level 1).
- Employer Rights and Responsibilities

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

- ➔ Candidates must have already achieved a Level 2 Hairdressing Qualification
- ➔ Must be employed status.
- ➔ Entry is normally subject to interview merit
- ➔ Mature applicants - Each application considered on individual merit
- ➔ Applicants should have 2 GCSEs at grade C or above to include English and Science
- ➔ Applicants may be required to undertake a practical skills test as part of the interview process

EQUIPMENT REQUIRED:

- ➔ Uniform, shoes and badge (approximating £60)
- ➔ Hairdressing kit (approximating £210)
- ➔ Stationery and books (approximating £45)
