### COURSE AIM:

This course will provide the knowledge and skills required for people employed in the motor vehicle industry, or the underpinning knowledge requirement of an NVQ 2. The course covers all aspects of Motor Vehicle maintenance and repair, to include vehicle servicing, fault identification and rectification.

Candidates will be expected to attend college one day/week for underpinning knowledge, and assessment will also take place in the workplace on a regular basis. This course is both theory and practical based. The framework consists of:

#### Heavy Vehicle:

- NVQ Diploma C & G Level 2 in Heavy Vehicle Maintenance and Repair Competence.
- C & G Level 2 Award in Knowledge of Employee Rights and Responsibilities
- C & G Level 2 Diploma in Heavy Vehicle Maintenance and Repair Principles.
- Essential Skills Wales: Application of Number, Communication (Level 1) and IT.
