## SHORT DESCRIPTION:

Apprenticeships are worked-based learning programmes designed around the needs of employers which lead to nationally recognised qualifications.

The City & Guilds Level 2 Diploma in Maintenance Occupations is a competence based qualification designed to reflect the work of construction staff with some supervisory duties across the Construction Industry. The qualification covers the practical skills and knowledge required to work in Maintenance Occupations and supervisory skills in the building industry. In the Level 2 Diploma learners can choose from a bank of optional units which show their ability covering every aspect of Maintenance, Maintaining no structural carpentry work. Repairing carpentry, replacing glazing. Moving and handling materials. Basic plumbing skills.

## JOB ROLE:

Job roles may include: construction maintenance operatives, basic to intermediate construction duties, handy man role, Caretaker role.
