SHORT DESCRIPTION:

Apprenticeships are worked-based learning programmes designed around the needs of employers which lead to nationally recognised qualifications.

The City & Guilds Level 2 Diploma in Trowel Occupations is a competence based and training qualification designed to reflect the work of Bricklaying staff across the Construction Industry. The qualification covers the practical skills and knowledge required to work in Trowel Occupations and building industry. In the Level 2 Diploma learners can choose from a bank of optional units which show their ability covering every aspect of Bricklaying, drainage, concrete and repairs, this includes setting out masonry work, building cavity walling, building solid walling, applying joint finishes and all health and safety aspects of the trade.

JOB ROLE:

Job roles may include: Building of traditional block and brick buildings, masonry cladding to timber frame or concrete/steel buildings. Also have access to the optional units such as; drainage, masonry repairs, plastering.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

There are no entry requirements, however, there are qualifications or experience that will help learners understand the sector prior to starting, such as:

- Level 1 Award in basic construction skills. Level 1 Diploma in Trowel Occupations.
- Work experience within the Construction industry

**COURSE ASSESSMENT / EXAMINATION:**

1 day per week attendance at College together with assessments in the work place.

PROGRESSION:

There are opportunities for workers to undertake further training or assessment of competence that enables them to progress within the industry. Level 3 Trowel Occupations.
