COURSE AIM:

This course is suitable for students to gain marine engineering skills such as Mechanical Installation and maintenance activities which are associated with marine construction, service and repair.

COURSE CONTENT:

Candidates will be expected to attend college one day/week for underpinning knowledge, and assessment will also take place in the workplace on a regular basis. This course is both theory and practical based. The framework consists of:

- EAL Level 2 NVQ Diploma in Marine Engineering.
- C & G Level 2 Marine Construction, Systems Engineering & Maintenance (2463).
- Essential Skills Wales: Application of Number, Communication, ICT (Core Essential skills) all at Level 1.
- Essential Skills Wales: Working With Others(WWO) and Improving Own Learning and Performance (IOLP)
- (Wider Essential Skills) all at Level 1.

We encourage all candidates to complete these at Level 2 for progression to the Level 3 framework.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be employed status.
- Entry is normally subject to interview merit, C & G L2 (2463) entry requirements two D grade GCSEs preferably Maths & English.
