COURSE AIM:

This course will provide the knowledge and skill requirements for employees within the Industry who have attained a Level 2 Qualification. It will cover the diagnostic knowledge and skills required by a motor vehicle technician. It will also provide the underpinning knowledge requirements of an NVQ 3. There is a practical element to this course and ideally you will need to be employed in the relevant trade to achieve the full qualification.

COURSE CONTENT:

Candidates will be expected to attend college one day/week for underpinning knowledge, and assessment will also take place in the workplace on a regular basis. This course is both theory and practical based. The framework consists of:

Light Vehicle:

- NVQ Diploma C & G Level 3 in Light Vehicle Maintenance and Repair Competence.
- C & G Level 2 Award in Knowledge of Employee Rights and Responsibilities
- C & G Level 3 Diploma in Light Vehicle Maintenance and Repair Principles.
- Essential Skills Wales: Application of Number, Communication and IT (Level 2).

Heavy Vehicle:

- NVQ Diploma C & G Level 3 in Heavy Vehicle Maintenance and Repair Competence.
- C & G Level 2 Award in Knowledge of Employee Rights and Responsibilities
- C & G Level 3 Diploma in Heavy Vehicle Maintenance and Repair Principles.
- Essential Skills Wales: Application of Number, Communication and IT (Level 2).

**ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:**

- Must be employed status.
- Entry is normally subject to interview merit.
- City and Guilds Level 2, or equivalent, or prior experience within the Industry.
