COURSE AIM:

This course is aimed at anyone working under supervision in a face-to-face role in a care setting.

COURSE CONTENT:

The course consists of the following:

- Essential Communication Skills (EComMS)
- Essential Application of Number Skills (EAoNS)
- Essential Digital Literacy Skills (EDLS)

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

There are no formal entry requirements but learners must be at least 16 years of age. Entry is subject to enhanced DBS check.

An initial assessment of each learner's suitability for entry to the Apprenticeship will be undertaken prior to enrolment.
