



Procedures for the exclusion of children with Infectious Diseases.

- Log date, time, name of child and date of birth.
- Check national Public Health service for Wales guidelines for the exclusion of pupils with infectious diseases from colleges, schools, nurseries and playgroups.
- Check to see if it is a notifiable disease.
- Contact Link Health Visitor – Angela Jones on Office - 01437 891749 or Mobile – 07810853373 OR If link Health visitor is not available contact the child's Health Visitor as long as permission from parent has been previously granted to do so (check their confirmation form for this).
- Contact member of Directorate Management Team if it is a confirmed notifiable disease.
- Check vaccination forms for children who have not been immunised against disease (if applicable)
- Once confirmed contact the National Public Health Board.
- If confirmed diagnosis contact parents involved if advised by the National Public Health Board.
- Log all information and conversations, date and sign.

Contact Curriculum Area Manager – Lucy Breckon, if extra support is needed or if the disease is notifiable.

Notifiable Diseases include:

- Diphtheria
- Hepatitis A
- Hepatitis B and C (Aids/HIV)
- German Measles (Rubella)
- Measles
- Mumps
- Meningococcal Meningitis/Septicaemia
- Meningitis due to other bacteria
- Viral Meningitis
- Scarlet Fever
- Typhoid (and Paratyphoid – Enteric fever)
- Tuberculosis
- Whooping Cough
