Student Placement Policy

Introduction:

- □ Written permission must be obtained from the child's parents if they are required to carry out a child study or observation.
- □ No names will be used during any recorded observations.

- □ Students are expected to maintain the highest ethical and professional standards.
- Confidentiality, respect, and a commitment to child safety are paramount.

Evaluation and Feedback:

- □ Continuous feedback will be provided to students to enhance their learning experience.
- □ Students are encouraged to provide feedback on their placement experience.
