## **What else do you need to know?**

### **College Trips and Activities**

While you are at college, you might take part in trips or activities depending on what course you are on. Some trips and visits need fitness tests or might include working with animals or using machines. Some are college team sports events or outdoor activities like rock climbing, hill walking, surfing and kayaking. Some trips mean staying overnight somewhere but these have their own consent forms.

The safety of all college activities is tested and your tutors have all the qualifications they need to make sure everyone on the trip is as safe as they can be. Any safety equipment needed is provided by the college.

There are some very strict rules when on a trip and you must listen and respond to instructions from tutors at all times. The drinking of alcohol is strictly not allowed and you could be sent home if rules are broken (which could cost money for parents /guardians and or carers).

### **COVID 19**

There will be strict COVID 19 rules in place at college in 2020/21, including for all trips. Learners might be sent home from college, trips and activities if these rules are broken.

### **Photographs at the College**

The college likes to take photos of learners for public adverts, leaflets, to use online, newspapers, television or social media. Sometimes photos and videos are needed for coursework. However, to take photos of you or make a video with you in it, the college needs permission from you.

- ✓ Work with our support teams to help you with your coursework, learning and with related activities
- ✓ Set your own personal targets for your learning
- ✓ Hand in all coursework on time and to the expected standard
- ✓ Tell the college if for some reason, you cannot attend any of your sessions or course activity
- ✓ Tell the college if your personal circumstances change at all e.g. your mobile number or email address
- ✓ Follow all the guidance and instructions in the LIVE Online Session Learner Agreement

 <p><b>Think More</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>✓ Help to make online sessions a safe place for everyone and work safely online at all times</li><li>✓ Listen and respond to instructions from your tutors at the start of the online session until the end</li><li>✓ Treat everyone in the online session with consideration and respect and do not swear</li><li>✓ You must not record, photograph or video anyone else, including your tutor, in the online session</li><li>✓ You must not upload or share anything unless asked to by your tutor, or upload work that is not yours</li></ul>
 <p><b>Learn More</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>✓ Attend all live online sessions included in your course</li><li>✓ If possible, find a quiet and calm space for your online session (without music, TV or pets etc.)</li><li>✓ Be on time for online sessions, fully prepared and ready to learn</li><li>✓ Make sure you are properly dressed (no pyjamas!)</li><li>✓ Stay online for the whole session and keep concentrating!</li><li>✓ Do what your tutor tells you about microphones on/off and when to chat and answer questions</li><li>✓ Work with our support teams in online sessions when you need help with your work and study</li><li>✓ Leave the online session as soon as your tutor tells you to</li><li>✓ Tell the college if for some reason, you cannot attend any of your online sessions</li><li>✓ Let your tutor know if for some reason, you do not feel safe in an online session</li></ul>

## This is your **Learner Finance Agreement**

**2020/2021**

If you apply for the **Education Maintenance Allowance (EMA)** while at college you must read the following agreement carefully:

- ✓ I confirm that any information I have previously submitted is still correct and that I have notified any changes, in accordance with my original application terms
- ✓ I understand that any attempt to dishonestly obtain EMA shall be treated as fraud and may result in criminal and/or civil proceedings against me
- ✓ I understand that as part of the EMA, the information which I have provided maybe subject to review as part of a sample check
- ✓ 100% attendance is required for EMA, if you are absent you must complete a paid absence form and provide evidence of appointments and only 10 days paid absence is allowed.
- ✓ Holidays in term time, persistent lateness, poor behaviour, poor work records will result in non-payment of EMA
- ✓ If any payment is stopped, it is your responsibility to discuss this with the EMA Team within 2 weeks of the stopped payment date

If you apply for a **Welsh Government Learning Grant Further Education (WGLG FE)** while at college you must read the following agreement carefully:

- ✓ I confirm that the information I have previously submitted is still correct and that I have notified any changes thereto in accordance with my original application terms
- ✓ I confirm that I have not been in receipt of any other funding from the Welsh Government for this level of study or course. Please note, this does not apply if you have previously received Education Maintenance Allowance
- ✓ I understand that any attempt to dishonestly obtain WGLG FE shall be treated as fraud and may result in criminal and/or civil proceedings against me
- ✓ I understand that as part of the WGLG FE, the information which I have provided maybe subject to review as part of a sample check
- ✓ I confirm that if I withdraw from my course, I will repay all or part of my WGLG FE allowance for all or part of the year

### **You also have to agree to the following:**

- ✓ For the college to share your information with your parent(s)/guardian(s) or partner in relation to EMA or WGLG (FE) support
- ✓ To tell the college, in which language (English or Welsh) you would like to be communicated with
- ✓ To let the college, know about any extenuating circumstances that might affect your attendance or study, such as being a carer for a family member
- ✓ To let the college, know if you need a nominated person who is responsible for your administrative and /or your finance matters, this could be because you have an additional learning needs or a disability

When applying for either of these funds, the college has to confirm that you have agreed to and signed your learner agreement (whether by ticking the electronic boxes when enrolling online or if you completed an enrolment process printed on paper).
