FUNDING TO ACHIEVE YOUR GOALS

DEGREE LEVEL COURSES

FULL-TIME STUDENTS

Tuition fee loan: Up to £9,000 per year. Repayments start when you are earning over £25,000 per year.

Maintenance support: Up to £12,260 per year depending on where you live and study.

Welsh Government Learning Grant: At least £1,000 - up to £10,124 depending on household income.

PART-TIME STUDENTS

Tuition fee loan: Up to £2,625 per year. Repayments start when you are earning over £25,000 per year.

Maintenance support: Up to £4,433 per year depending on household income and study intensity.

Welsh Government Learning Grant: At least £250 - up to £4,500 depending on household income and study intensity.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTES TO HIGHER LEVELS OF LEARNING:

HIGHER APPRENTICESHIPS offer an attractive route to gaining higher level qualifications and are fully funded by Welsh Government. Higher Apprenticeships involve assessment of competence in the workplace, essential skills qualifications and a knowledge certificate which may be a Foundation Degree or an HNC. You are required to be employed in a relevant industry and have permission to enrol from your employer.

SKILLS FOR INDUSTRY FUNDING may be available for employers who wish for their employees to up-skill. Depending on the size of the company/business, subsidies of up to 70% are available, eligibility criteria applies - please contact: sfi@pembrokeshire.ac.uk to see if you are eligible.

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ART & DESIGN PROGRAMMES

Do you want to work within the creative industries? Do you enjoy research, investigating materials, challenging yourself, problem solving, and creating solutions? If so this BA Design course may be right for you.

The course offers you the chance to explore a range of art and design specialisms. In the first year you will work through a series of modules covering Graphic Design and Illustration, Textile Design, Fashion Design and 3 Dimensional Design. These modules are underpinned by further modules in Visual Studies and Contextual Studies.

The understanding of contemporary and historical practice together with colour, form, texture and composition - the "formal elements" - are essential ingredients for any artists/designers' education. Our emotions are highly influenced by these elements motivating individual responses to the aesthetic qualities of the marks being made.

The focus of the first year is to give you an introduction to a range of skills while furthering your understanding of the creative process of research, design development and production of outcome. Continuous development of new techniques and production methods, together with an artistic response to a theme opens a wealth of research opportunities and provides a host of design ideas. The second and third years provide the opportunity to develop specialist areas of choice while still being able to move across workshops and use other facilities to support your work.

The, 60 credit, final major project in the third year is a self-initiated brief. You can select to follow a commercial or fine art route. Outcomes emerge from an intuitive inquiry in response to the engagement with these materials, allowing the original concept to undergo a complete metamorphosis.

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COMPUTING PROGRAMMES

Computing based courses are amongst the most popular courses studied worldwide. Our lecturers set out to help you develop practical skills to equip you with the knowledge that businesses are looking for and to help you get ahead in your career. Our computing degree routes are accredited by the University of Wales Trinity Saint David.

HNC/HND IN APPLIED COMPUTING

These programmes enable students to become capable of complete system management, software development, the installation of IT networks, and much more. The array of specialist modules and practical work placements mean you will become accustomed to the working practices, and learn the key skills necessary to succeed in the IT industry.

TAKE THE MODULAR ROUTE

If you are unsure whether Higher Education is for you, you can study our HNC Computing programme via a modular approach. Each 20 credit module is £567. A maximum of 40 credits can be studied in an academic year on a modular basis and this would lead to you gaining an Award in Higher Education, this could then be topped-up to a HNC.

Highly regarded by employers, these well-established vocational qualifications will help you to develop a sound understanding of leadership roles within the construction industry as well as the execution of construction processes.



The PGCE (Post Graduate Certificate in Education) prepares both graduates and non-graduates for employment within the post-16 teaching/training sector, including further education, private training, nurse education, training in industry and public services.

The PGCE is offered up to Level 7, if you do not already have a degree you can still enrol and graduate with a PCE (Post Certificate in Education).

We also offer the Level 4 Higher Apprenticeship in Advice and Guidance. 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ENGINEERING PROGRAMMES

The College works closely with local industry to ensure that our engineering qualifications are current and meet industry standards. Students have access to top engineering facilities including the Virtual Control Training Room for hazardous safety modules.

Higher National qualifications provide specialist vocational learning at levels 4 and 5, reflecting the requirements of professional organisations and meeting the National Occupational Standards for industry.

The HND full-time pathway presents an opportunity for students either to graduate after two years with a Diploma (level 5) or progress to the third year at the University of Wales Trinity Saint David in Carmarthen.

TOP-UP PATHWAYS TO A BSc IN:

Automotive Engineering | Motorsport Engineering | Mechanical & Manufacturing | Mechanical Engineering

To undertake the HNC pathway (usually one day per week) candidates will ideally be engaged in suitable full time employment. The specific work element will be met through the completion of an industry based project.

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ENGINEERING BLENDED ONLINE LEARNING

A CAREER IN ENGINEERING CAREER VIA ONLINE LEARNING

Having built a reputation for quality training spanning over half century, Pembrokeshire College will be offering online engineering courses from September 2020. Working in consultation with industry, the College is developing two Higher National Certificates (HNCs), validated by the University of Wales Trinity Saint David, in **Process Operations and Instrumentation**. Ideally suited for those who do not want conventional classroom-based teaching, this flexible model will be hugely beneficial for those who want to become an engineering technician in the oil and gas or food and drink manufacturing industries. Each pathway will teach you a range of disciplines that will help you develop skills to progress your career through employment or towards a full BSc/BEng degree.

THE BENEFITS OF ONLINE LEARNING:

Flexible delivery will allow you to learn from the comfort of your home or at your workplace. Because we appreciate that distance learning isn't for everyone, especially when you are working, the College has developed a blended model to make your learning journey relevant, stimulating and varied. As much as we are all looking for flexibility, sometimes a full online platform is not always the best substitute for face-to-face teaching, this is why a blended approach is an effective model. The HNCs will consist of a blend of classroom and online; this presents an opportunity to mix with learners from various industries, share practice and make new associates.

HOW WILL YOU LEARN:

Block Release: Course content will include practical learning elements. Pembrokeshire College has industrial standard workshops – an ideal environment for you to fine tune or learn new engineering techniques. The three blocks per year will be designed for laboratory and workshop-based sessions and assessments, face-to-face lecturers and examinations.

When will the Blocks run?

- September 2020
- January 2021
- June 2021

LIVE school: is a platform developed by the College to offer 'real time' lectures. This is a tutor led platform that offers interaction between the students and the tutor, don't worry if you cannot make the scheduled lecture because of a shift change, you can catch up by accessing the recorded session.

Moodle: is an online learning hub; the course units, learning material and resources are all accessed from here. You can download course information and upload your completed assignments via this portal.

Tutor Support: This is vital to your success on the programme. All your assignments are tutor marked, some of which will be recorded voice assessments and others written. We will respond to your questions within 24 hours or less.

PROGRESS TO OR FROM TECHNICIAN LEVEL

The course is for learners who wish to work as a technician in instrumentation and control engineering design, process operations, manufacture, maintenance, testing or fault finding or the communications industries. For engineering technicians who want to progress to a supervisory or management role this is ideal to underpin practical experience with academic study. It has been developed in consultation with local industry, and combines theory and practical work with the focus being on industrial applications.

HEALTH & CARE PROGRAMMES

At Pembrokeshire College we are proud to deliver sector leading practice in the health care, child care and adult care sectors. All our courses are work-based and designed to fit around busy careers.

To embark on one of our higher apprenticeship programmes you will need to be employed in an appropriate role in an appropriate setting.

These qualifications will give you the opportunity to build both your managerial and care skills, allowing you to help more people and progress within your sector or gain the formal qualifications needed within your setting.

NEW! FOUNDATION DEGREE IN HEALTH AND SOCIAL CARE


