


ENTERPRISE ANNUAL IMPACT

REPORT 2023/24 -



In keeping with the Welsh Government's Economic Action Plan, the College is committed to inclusivity and the fostering of entrepreneurial skills and innovate thinking for all.

Funding from Welsh Government has been instrumental in enabling Pembrokeshire College to build and develop enterprise activities and opportunities for learners.

For term one of 2023/24 the Enterprise Officer role was vacant, the figures included here relate to terms 2 and 3 where a structured entrepreneurship journey and delivery plan for learners was followed with consideration of:

- The Engage, Empower and Equip framework.
- Maximising the reach and impact of enterprise activity, whilst delivering value for money through all activity.
- Equality and Welsh language.
- Partnership working with regional delivery partners and stakeholders and business and community engagement.



Engage: learners introduced to entrepreneurship


During 2023/24 over 900 learners attended talks, workshops and awareness raising events

DIGITAL ENTERPRISE

Funding was secured from OGI to run a free part-time digital enterprise course with a £750 prize for the best business venture and ongoing mentoring from OGI

Almost 50 learners took the opportunity to test trade whilst 12 went on to start their own business



PARTNERSHIPS
